- involve our supply chain in the importance of applying current and future sustainability initiatives;
- communicate and report above mentioned initiatives in a correct, transparent and complete way;
- promote awareness and training on sustainability theme, towards our employees and, as much as possible, towards our suppliers and toward local communities where we work;

Above all we have decided to address the topic of conscious use of resources with the aim to reduce consumption and environmental impacts in a structural way, inside the production cycles.

To follow this protocol means also contributing to the achievement of **Sustainable Development Goals 2030**, adopted by the United Nations (SDGs), in particular we can contribute to the following:

















Having a look to above mentioned goals, we have adopted **4sustainability® Planet Protocol**, which implements actionable projects for reducing water consumption, energy consumption and CO2eq emissions in atmosphere and allows to measure periodically and clearly the level of application.



Protocol Planet implantation recognises and develops system certifications, internationally recognised, such as:

- ISO 14001:2015 environmental management systems -Requirements and user guide;
- ISO 50001:2018 energy management systems Requirements and user guide;
- ISO 14046:2016 "Environmental management -Water Footprint -Principles, Requirements and guide lines";
- ISO 16064:2019 "Green House Gas -Part 1: Specifications and guide as far as concerns organisation, quantification and reporting of GHG emissions and their removal";
- OEF Organisation Environmental Footprint with the aim to evaluate products/services/organisations environmental performances, during their lifecycle, made in accordance with the Recommendation 179/2013 European Commission;

The project, which is currently underway, includes:

- General part
 - to appoint an internal Sustainability Manager with a system management team;
 - direct and indirect environmental aspects mapping/evaluation, relating to our own company activity;
 - improvement plan on the significant environmental aspects, previously identified;
- Organisation Carbon Footprint part, which includes:
 - System border definition and emission list, which are object of this study, together with inventory details necessary for evaluation and analysis;
 - Supply Chain Mapping: raw materials and processes suppliers list, identification of geographical location and purchased or processed volumes by each supplier, in the reference year;
 - o Suppliers involvement through consumption details request, specific to production;
 - Elaboration of counted direct emissions detailed report, correlation with compensation and removal activities;
- Quality and quantity annual check, which certify requirements have been actually applied and in which measure, realising an implementation Level of Protocol 4S (Ongoing, Basic, Advanced, Excellence) and a synthetic report with KPI, to share with our own customers and stakeholder, either in pdf version or in digital one (e-report).



Credible sustainable development paths are built through qualified partnership and a continuous innovation. We are therefore available to share our steps, publishing our reference documents, discussing eventual proposals, checking together the viable paths, all above mentioned behaviours with the aim to proceed in an improvement, transparent, shared and concrete path.
